News in Brief....

Neighbourhood Watch

PC Shelley Shaladan is leaving in August and being replaced by PC Virginie Freval from Portswood Police Station. We have written to thank PC Shelley Shaladan for all her hard work and to wish her well.



The Police rely on the public to supply information about all crime, small or large, but Neighbourhood Watch is not simply about crime. It is about being the 'eyes and ears' of the community to help each other and the Police, being alert to anything unusual or suspicious, looking out for your neighbours and looking after vulnerable and elderly residents to make sure that they are safe in their own local environment. In essence it is about being a good neighbour.

Planning: 14/00429/OUT - Land At Vermont Close -

This highly controversial proposal a 120 bed student hall on Vermont Close has now been passed, with zero car parking provision, despite intense opposition from local residents. The developer claims that they will have a "no car" clause in their tenancy agreements - however, residents and users of the Sports centre fear this will be legally unenforceable, resulting in cars being parked in Vermont Close and in the unadopted track leading down to the ski slope.

The Bassett Plan

The draft plan is now with the Council being assessed for sustainability. Following this, a public consultation will take place over a 6 week period, hopefully some time this Autumn. We will also arrange a public meeting one night at All Saints' with Cllr Les Harris, Chair of the Neighbourhood Forum, so that he can go through the specifics of the Plan for our area. Following the consultation, the Plan will then go to an independent adjudicator. Ultimately it will be the subject of a local referendum for all residents of Bassett Ward and, if approved, will formally be in place, which means it will carry legal weight in the planning process.

Watch for further news and register your vote to help retain Bassett Ward the way you wish it to be. Your support in the referendum will be essential. The Localism Act affects us all - so do get involved at the appropriate time!

Monday 18th August Dementia Awareness Training

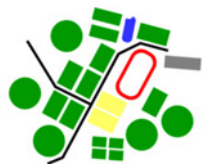
